On Wednesday 17th December pupils in Diamonds and Year 1 are invited to go and watch The Little Mermaid pantomime at the Playhouse Theatre.

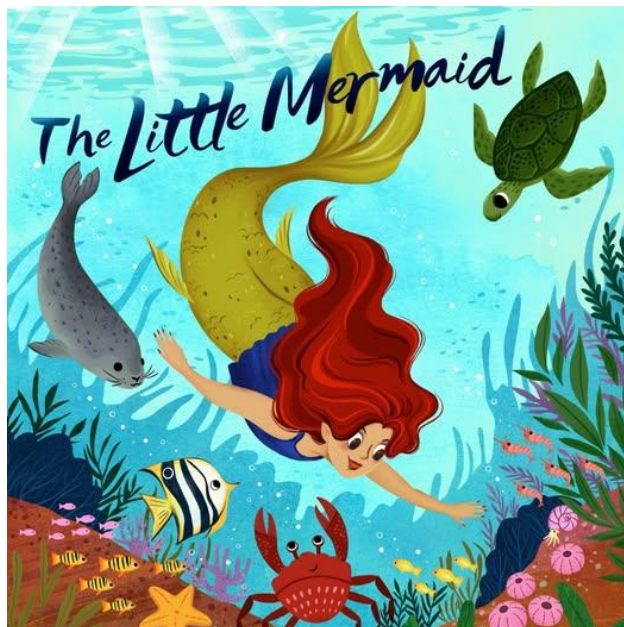
We will be travelling to and from the theatre by bus.
